

BUDGET PUBLIC MEETING

December 16, 2019

A Public Meeting was held on December 16, 2019 in the Rose Valley Borough Office, 9 Old Mill Lane, Rose Valley, Pa. to solicit public comment regarding the proposed 2020 Budget. President of Council Bill Hale called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. Other Council members present were: Councilpersons Deb DeMasi, Stephanie Middleton, Bob Siwicki, Judy Voet and Vippy Yee; Mayor Tim Plummer, Treasurer Joe Hare, Controller John Neilson; Solicitor G. Guy Smith and Secretary Paula Healy. Council member Dave Firm was absent due to illness. No members of the public attended.

The Proposed 2020 Budget for the Borough of Rose Valley has been on display in the Borough Office for the public to view since November 14, 2019. The legally required viewing period was advertised in the Delaware County Daily Times on November 20 and 21, 2019.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, Mr. Hale asked if there were any comments on the proposed 2020 budget. There were none. On a motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the meeting was closed at 7:35 pm.

COUNCIL MEETING

December 16, 2019

A special meeting of the Rose Valley Borough Council was held on December 16, 2019 in the Rose Valley Borough Office, 9 Old Mill Lane, Rose Valley, Pa. to approve the 2020 Budget. President of Council Bill Hale called the meeting to order at 7:36 p.m. The Council members present and absent are listed above.

The Proposed 2020 Budget for the Borough of Rose Valley has been on display in the Borough Office for the public to view since November 14, 2019. The legally required viewing period was advertised in the Delaware County Daily Times on November 20 and 21, 2019.

Mr. Siwicki reviewed the proposed 2020 Budget, which calls for the millage rate to remain at 2.04 mills, total revenue and expenses of \$400,949, an increase in the contribution to both the Helen Kate Furness Library and the Rose Valley Centennial Foundation from \$20,000 to \$23,000, and an appropriation from Capital Reserve of \$45,000. Mr. Siwicki asked if there were any comments or questions on the proposed Budget. There being none, Mr. Siwicki made a motion to approve the Final 2020 Budget which was subsequently seconded and unanimously approved.

The following end-of-year Resolutions and Ordinance were then approved on motions made, seconded and unanimously approved:

Resolution 4 – Setting salaries and employee benefits for 2020

Resolution 5 – Setting fees for permits in 2020

Ordinance 350 – Setting the millage rate at 2.04 for 2020

There being no further business, on a motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the meeting adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
